Arad is located in the very Western part of Romania, being a medium sized city with beautiful architecture.

It is located in the lower Mures River valley close to the Hungarian border, about 30 miles (50 km) north-northeast of Timisoara.



How to get to Arad

There is no big airport in the city but Arad has good road and railway connections. The nearest airport is **Timisoara** "Traian Vuia" airport

Other options for travel by air is landing to Budapest (HU) airport (258 km away) and then taking a shuttle to Arad, Romania. We, oftentimes, prefer to use this solution instead of Bucharest International Airport (550 km away).

The national currency of Romania is the Romanian leu (RON).




